School uniform

This term the weather has continued to be unseasonably warm throughout the day and the students have been able to wear either the summer or winter uniform to accommodate this. From Monday 3 **June** all students are expected to wear their full winter uniform to school.

An outline of winter uniform items and a pricing list is attached in this newsletter for your reference. Purchases from the uniform store can be made through the school office at any time or Tara is available on Monday's before and after school at the uniform shop in the 1/2 block. Alternatively there are many pre -loved items available through a swap and go system in the uniform shop.

Girls who choose to wear tights with tunics are reminded that only "grey' coloured tights are to be worn. All students are to wear only the Como PS red bucket hat or peak cap to school, these can be purchased from the uniform shop for \$15 each. Please ensure all clothing items are clearly labelled with your child's name.

Sunscreen

We have recently purchased large 30+ cancer council sunscreen pump containers for all classrooms and the staffroom. These will be mounted on the walls and students will be able to access the sunscreen throughout the day. The teachers will monitor and encourage usage. However, if you do not wish for your child to use this sunscreen while at school and have alternative arrangements in place to keep them sun-safe, please notify your child's class teacher in writing.

Our school is once again participating in the Sutherland Shire Schools Music Festival at the Sutherland Entertainment Centre (SEC) in August. Tickets for this event will only be available online. This year the sale date for concerts will be staggered.

Tickets for our Concert 8 Imbruglia go on sale on Friday 14 June 2018

On this day, tickets will be available to anyone wishing to purchase on a first-in, first served basis. As tickets traditionally sell out for some of the concerts, we recommend you order yours as early as possible. In the unlikely event that there are unsold tickets for a particular concert, these will be available at the box office on afternoon/night of the concert.

Tickets this year are \$19.50. Due to health and safety regulations, the Sutherland Entertainment Centre will not allow children to sit on parents' laps. Each person attending the concert will require a ticket.



This is a six-session program for separated parents in conflict over their children. It is designed to improve emotional and developmental outcomes for children in separated families by:

- raising parents' awareness of the impact on their children of the ongoing conflict in their family
- providing them with knowledge, tips and strategies to be able to focus on their children rather than on their issues or conflicts with the other parent

Parents will learn:

- ways to better regulate their emotions and to self-care
- ways to help their children manage their emotions
- to recognise the effects of ongoing, mismanaged conflict on children
- skills to better manage conflict with the other parent
- to reorient interactions with their child's other parent to be respectful and cooperative
- to recognise and differentiate between their own and their children's individual needs
- skills to communicate effectively with the other parent
- to reflect on their behaviour and make changes where needed
